1	September 2012	Creating project team in every school. Gathering information for the project website.
2	October 2012	Project logo competition among the two schools. Voting for logo and choosing a project logo.
3	Nov - Dec 2012	Designing the project website.
4	Jan - Feb 2013	Exchanging information, photos, presentations and videos about schools, towns, countries.
5	March 2013	Preparation for the clean-up campaign /pledge, emails, leaflets, posters, meetings/
6	April 2013	First Clean-up campaign in the towns of the both participating schools.
7	May – June 2013	Creating e-newspaper/booklet about the project and school activities. Preparation for the meeting in Romania. Language classes in Romanian for the Bulgarian students and teachers.
8	July 2013	Project meeting in Romania. While exploring Retezat National Park we will have two activities: - Competition among students- compass orientation - Field research- studying species of plants and animals that are protected by laws.
9	September 2013	Evaluation of the previous year
10	October 2013	Second Clean-up campaign in the towns of the both participating schools.
11	November 2013	Workshops- decorative objects and jewelry, napkin's rings, trays and vases of paper will be made in both schools, showing that newspapers and magazines can be reused and turned into creative objects.
12	December 2013	Producing specific eco Christmas decorations and organizing bazaars at schools
13	January 2014	Exchanging information, pictures, presentations and videos about the workshops at schools.
14	February 2014	Creating leaflets about endangered species from each country
15	March 2014	World Water Day - March 22 examining water quality near schools and creating presentations about the importance of water
16	April 2014	22nd APRIL Earth Day - soil quality examination and essay contest "Earth in the future"
17	May 2014	Creating a school play on eco theme. Creating a booklet about eco-friendly planet/environment.
18	June 2014	"A clean environment, a better life" - June 5- World Environment Day exhibition of paintings Preparation for the meeting in Bulgaria. Language classes in Bulgarian for the Romanian students and teachers.
19	July 2014	Project meeting in Bulgaria. Creating eco-friendly path in the forest near the town and tree planting in the forest.
20	August 2014	Final evaluation and dissemination of the project results.
